Three types of clay brick were submitted to AMT Laboratories by PROSOCO, Inc. with a request to determine the most appropriate new construction cleaner. Additionally, adverse effects testing on stain removal/maintenance cleaners suitable for clay brick were evaluated.

The laboratory report (2405-05 PTP Glen-Gery) provides information about the PROSOCO® products tested and descriptions of the test methods. The report includes test results as well as conclusions and recommendations. Recommendations are also provided in the chart below.
