

Liquid Marble Cleaner

Sure Klean® Liquid Marble Cleaner is a non-acidic, phosphate-free, low-odor, orange-colored gel designed for the cleaning, restoration and maintenance of polished stonework or glazed masonry. Liquid Marble Cleaner loosens and dissolves surface dirt, carbon buildup and other atmospheric stains, allowing them to be washed away with a simple water rinse.

ADVANTAGES

- An effective, non-acidic restoration cleaning compound.
- Phosphate-free formulation.
- Will not etch glass or metal surfaces.
- Gel-like consistency controls dripping. Material "clings" to vertical surfaces.
- Low-odor and non-fuming Ideal for interior application.

Limitations

- May dull or remove waxes or other applied finishes.

PREPARATION

Protect people, vehicles, property, plants and all surfaces not designated to be cleaned from product, splash, wind drift, residue, and rinse water. Protect/divert auto and foot traffic.

Protect plants and painted surfaces with polyethylene or other proven protective material.

Sure Klean® Strippable Masking is appropriate for use with this product to protect glass and metal.

Surface & Air Temperatures

Best cleaning results are obtained when air and masonry surface temperatures are 40°F (4°C) or above. To avoid harm to masonry, do not clean when temperatures are below freezing or will be overnight. If freezing conditions exist prior to application, let masonry thaw.

Equipment

Apply with a soft-bristled brush. Spray application is normally not suitable.

Rinse with fresh water using a sponge or brush, or use pressure-rinsing equipment.

To prevent damage to masonry, use pressure-rinsing equipment generating 400–1000 psi with a water flow rate of 6–8 gallons per minute. Use a 15–45° fan spray tip. Heated water (150–180°F; 65–82°C) may improve cleaning efficiency. Use adjustable equipment for reducing water flow-rates and rinsing pressure as needed for sensitive surfaces.

Rinsing pressures greater than 1000 psi and fan spray tips smaller than 15° may permanently damage sensitive masonry. Water flow-rates less than 6 gallons per minute may reduce cleaning productivity and contribute to uneven cleaning results.

Storage and Handling

Store in a cool, dry place with adequate ventilation. Keep tightly closed when not dispensing. Do not alter or mix with other chemicals. Published shelf life assumes upright storage of factory-sealed containers in a dry place. Maintain temperature of $45\text{-}100^{\circ}$ F (7-38° C). Do not double stack pallets. Dispose of unused product and container in accordance with local, state and federal regulations.

APPLICATION

Read "Preparation" and the Safety Data Sheet before use.

ALWAYS TEST a small area of each surface to confirm suitability, coverage rate and desired results before beginning overall application. Include in the test area any previous repairs and patches, including aesthetic cementitious finishes. Different surface compositions may result in absorption and/or appearance differences. Test each type of masonry and each type of stain. Test with the same equipment, recommended surface preparation and application procedures planned for general application. On older masonry, test pressurerinse as well. Let surface dry thoroughly before inspection.

Dilution & Mixing

Do not alter or use for purposes other than specified.

For heaving soiling, use in concentrate.

For light soiling, dilute with up to 3 parts water.

Typical Coverage Rates

Coverage varies based on surface texture, surface porosity, weather conditions at the time of application and the severity of soiling. Always test. Do not over apply.

• 1-gallon of *undiluted* product treats 75–200 sq.ft. (7–19 sq.m.)

Application Instructions

- 1. Liberally apply cleaner to the surface using a soft-bristled brush.
- 2. Leave the cleaner on the surface for 15–20 minutes. Do not let the gel dry on the surface.
- 3. Rinse the surface thoroughly with fresh water using sponges, brush and bucket, or low-pressure rinsing. Change rinse water frequently. Thorough rinsing is extremely important to ensure all residues are removed from the surface.

Cleanup

Clean tools and equipment with soap and water.
